a classic account of democracy's crisis of legitimacy the age of party democracy has passed argues peter mair in ruling the void the major parties have become so disconnected from society that they no longer seem capable of sustaining democracy in its present form first published in 2013 ruling the void presciently observed that the widening gap between citizens and their political leaders posed a crisis of legitimacy for the governing class and was fuelling populist mobilizations against it europe's political elites had remodelled themselves as a homogeneous professional class withdrawing into state institutions that offer relative stability in a world of fickle voters meanwhile non democratic agencies and practices proliferated not least among them the european union itself mair weighs the impact of these changes and offers an authoritative assessment of the prospects for popular political representation today not only in the varied democracies of britain and the eu but throughout the developed world with a new introduction by chris bickerton author of the european union a citizen's guide

for a long time analyses of political parties were framed within the usual context of democracy and of the historical transformation of the forms of democratic government more recently several authors among which eminently peter mair progressively began to question the relationship between the normative definition of democratic government and the actual operation of parties these new concerns are well epitomized by the tension between responsiveness and responsibility that gives the title to this book while classic democratic theory sees as desirable that parties in government and in opposition too are sympathetically responsive to their supporters first and more generally to public opinion and at the same time responsible toward the internal and international systemic constraints and compatibilities these two roles seem to have become more difficult to reconcile and even increasingly incompatible the chapters of this book explore the tensions between responsiveness and responsibility decomposing the international sources from the domestic sources and discussing the options and the possibilities for political parties to continue to play the role of provider of political stability in rapidly changing domestic and international environments this book was published as a special issue of west european politics

when why and how are democratic institutions reformed this is the broad question guiding this research rooted in a context of crises of representative democracy core democratic rules can be understood as the formal political rules regulating the direct relationship between elites within the political system parties and citizens they are therefore the cornerstone of the functioning of any political system this book deals with the context the motives and the mechanisms explaining the incidence of institutional
